

ALLOCATION NOTICE & FEE SCHEDULE

When your application is returned to the Village Clerk \$250.00 must be included for each allocation requested. (One unit is considered 450 gallons per day.) A sketch of your plans and the exact location must be provided at the time of your request.

Upon approval of your allocation request you have two (2) years to make the actual hook-up to the main line of the village. The exact place of the connection to the main must be provided.

When ready to hook onto the Village line you must first file with the Village Clerk, your hook-up application and a check for \$1000.00 for each connection allocation to be.

The Village superintendent must be notified at least 48 hours in advance of your plans for connection. No hook-ups may be done without the payment of the hook-up fees.

After hook-up to the main and when you are ready to occupy the subject property you must have a water meter installed. The meter will be provided by the Village. However any construction or costs of construction must be paid by the property owner. You must also file with this office a final connection approval form. (This will notify the village that you are ready to use our system.)

The last and final form is the notification of use. Once this form is filed we will officially know you are using our services and will be billed.

Hook-up Fees:

Water / Sewer fees \$1,250.00 each

Connection Fees:

When you actually connect to the system

Water \$1,000.00 each

Sewer \$1,000.00 each

Allocation Fees:

When you apply for allocation

Water \$250.00 / Sewer \$250.00 each

One person may not hold more than 4 water and 4 sewer allocations at one time.
